Please Note :

Air Transfers are in light aircraft and there is a weight restriction of **20 kg per person** including hand luggage. Luggage must be packed in **soft hold-all type bags**. Any extra luggage can be left with our office in Maun.

Please pack riding clothes in your hand luggage as any unforeseen luggage delays could impact on the orientation ride which will be scheduled for your arrival.

Jodhpurs	At least two pairs
Half Chaps	To wear with Jodhpurs
Leather Chaps	Alternative to Jodhpurs
Light Cotton Trousers	To wear under chaps and or evenings
Shorts	For the midday break
Long sleeve shirt optional	Protection from the sun while riding
T Shirts	
Swim suit	
Kikoi or Sarong	
Socks	2 changes per day (laundry is done daily except on camp moves)
Rubber Flip Flops	1 pair
Riding Shoes	1 pair
Trainers	1 pair of shoes to wear when not riding
Slacks	or similar for evenings
Sweat shirt	
Warm Jacket	Winter (April to September)
Hat	Hard for riding if preferred, wide brim / straw for shade
Riding Gloves	
Plastic Poncho	Rainy season
Torch	(and spare batteries)

All clothes should be neutral, khaki or bush coloured for riding and walking

	Lip ice
	Insect repellent
	Antihistamine cream and pills
	Bumbag (Fanny Pack)
	Camera (small pocket-sized for riding – larger camera for walking & game drives),

Please Note :

- Laundry is done daily in camp but not when moving to fly camp. All laundry is washed by hand by camp staff. Ladies underwear and other personal items may **not** be sent to the laundry. Washing powder is provided in the bathrooms.
- Soap, shampoo, hair conditioner and body lotion is provided in Kujwana camp.
- Bedrolls are complete with sheets, duvet and towels provided.
- A medical kit is available.
- Recharging batteries: facilities are available at Kujwana camp. Power point is round 3-pronged South African and Botswana
